## ***10:10:10 -- 10 Local Artists, 10 Linear Feet, 10 Self-Curated Exhibitions***

From photography to drawings to paintings, including two-dimensional and three-dimensional works, 10:10:10 features the works of ten regional artists, each given ten linear feet to self-curate their exhibition.
