

**What is it?** *Public Works* is a community-wide art exhibit. This is an opportunity for ALL ARTISTS to have their work exhibited from May 26 through July 22 at the Arts Council.

**Who is eligible?** YOU ARE, if you live in Bladen, Cumberland, Harnett, Hoke, Lee, Montgomery, Moore, Richmond, Robeson, Sampson, and Scotland Counties, Fort Bragg or Pope Field.

**What is accepted?** ALL ARTWORK, ANY ARTWORK, 2-D & 3-D from anybody, any age!!! Everything that gets hung must be in a sturdy frame with wire on the back. No plastic box frames, uni-frames or sawtooth hangers. Entries must all be original and not previously entered into ANY Arts Council exhibition.

**How many works may I enter?** The entry fee of \$15 for non-Arts Council members (or \$20 for two entries) and \$10 for Arts Council members (or \$15 for two entries). All entry fees are nonrefundable.

**Who's liable for what?** The Arts Council is not responsible for loss or damage while your works are in the pipeline (on the way from your place to ours and back again). Your works are insured while they're hung in the Arts Council's galleries.

**What if my works sell?** Hey, that's not just a pipe dream. They just might! The Arts Council will retain a 30% commission on all works sold (and that's definitely not water down the drain). If your work is not for sale, an insurance value MUST be placed on the entry form.



**What is the "People's Choice"?** Your art could win! During the 4th Friday opening on May 26, and during gallery hours on Saturday, May 27, visitors are invited to submit votes on their favorite works of art for a "People's Choice." The artwork with the largest number of votes will then be featured on the Arts Council's Facebook page for a Virtual Vote.

**What can I win?** Winners of the "People's Choice" will enjoy a gift basket full of unique items from downtown businesses. Winners of the online Virtual Vote will get Arts Council goody bags, including the popular backpack.

**So now what?** Bring your art to the Arts Council (301 Hay St.), between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Friday, May 12; and between noon and 4 p.m., Saturday, May 13. Your pieces will be displayed until Saturday, July 22.

**When do I pick my works up?** All work must be picked up between Tuesday, July 25, and Thursday, July 27, between noon and 4 p.m. Absolutely no early pick up! If you fail to pick up your work on those dates, you will have to call for an appointment to recover your work (910-323-1776). All artwork not picked up by Aug. 1, 2017, will become the property of the Arts Council.
